

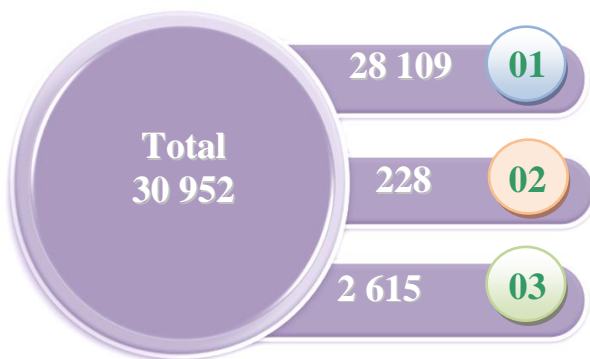
### III. AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES

As of January 1, 2025, the number of enterprises and organizations operating in agriculture, forestry and fisheries (except for farms and dehqan farms) amounted to 30 952 units, of which 28 109 units were in crop and livestock production, hunting and provision of services in these areas, 228 units in forestry and 2 615 units in fisheries.

In January-December 2024, the number of newly created enterprises and organizations operating in agriculture, forestry and fisheries (except for farms and dehqan farms) amounted to 9 117 units.

It should be noted that the largest number of enterprises and organizations is noted in the Kashkadarya region - 3 965 units, or 12.8 % of the total number of enterprises and organizations operating in this sector of the republic, while the smallest number of enterprises and organizations is recorded in the Tashkent city - 589 units (1.9 %).

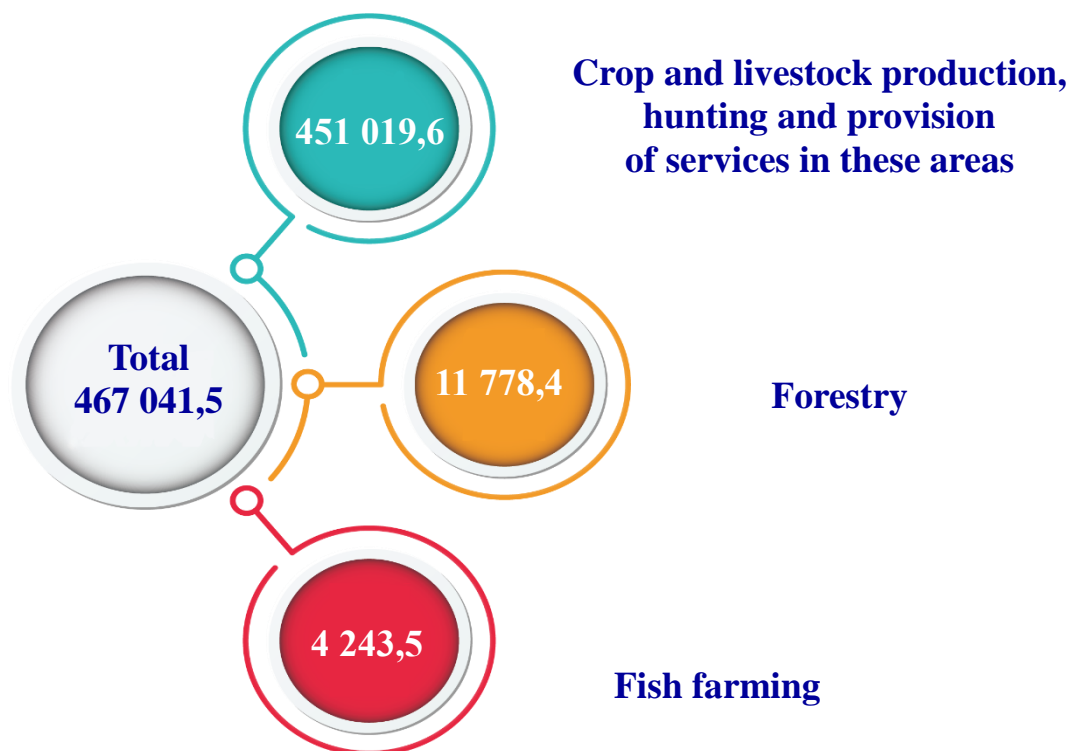

## SECTION 1. VOLUME (SERVICES) OF AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES

**Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries** is the total value of products and services created in the industry both for sale and for own consumption, formed on the basis of the gross output of products (services) of crop and livestock production, the value of products (services) produced in hunting, forestry and logging, fisheries and aquaculture.

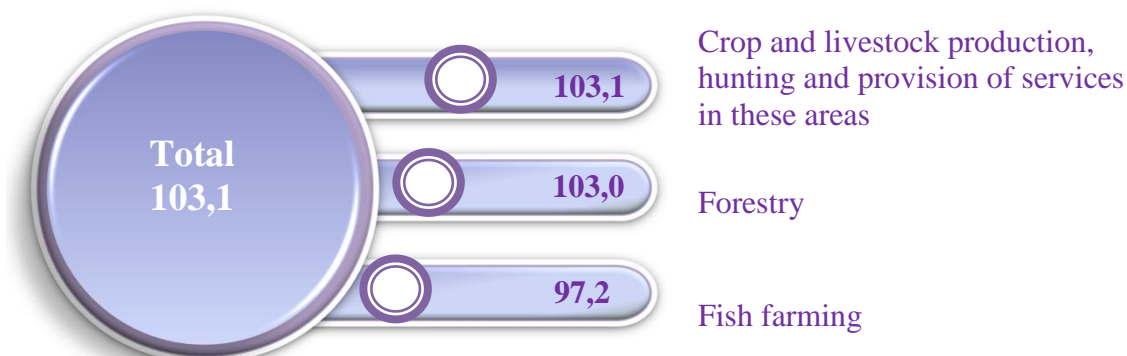
According to preliminary data, the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-December 2024 amounted to 467 041.5 billion soums, including in crop production and livestock farming, hunting and provision of services in these areas - 451 019.6 billion soums, forestry - 11 778.4 billion soums, fisheries - 4 243.5 billion soums.

In January-December 2024, the growth rate of products (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries, compared with the same period in 2023, amounted to 103.1 % (in January-December 2023, compared with the same period in 2022 - 104.1 %), including in crop production and livestock farming, hunting and the provision of services in these areas - 103.1 % (104.1 %), forestry - 103.0 % (102.9 %), fisheries - 97.2 % (104.1 %).

in agriculture, forestry and fisheries (%)**



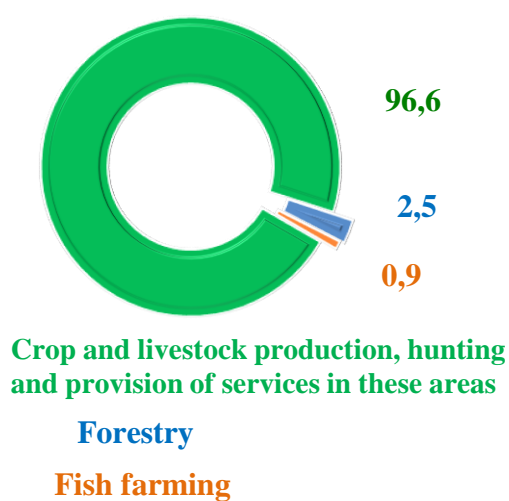
**Agricultural output** is a general indicator of the volume of agricultural production and is defined as the sum of the value of crop and livestock products produced in the reporting period in farms, dehqan and subsidiary farms and organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

**Hunting** includes the activities of hunting and catching wild animals, services in this area, as well as expenses for the conservation, breeding and treatment of game animals and birds in nurseries and farms.

**Forestry** is a branch of industry whose activities are related to the reproduction and use of forest resources, in particular forestry, afforestation and the production of round timber for wood processing industries, as well as the collection of wild forest products.

**Fisheries** - a type of activity related to fishing and conservation of aquatic bioresources, aquaculture, production and sale of fish and other products from aquatic bioresources.

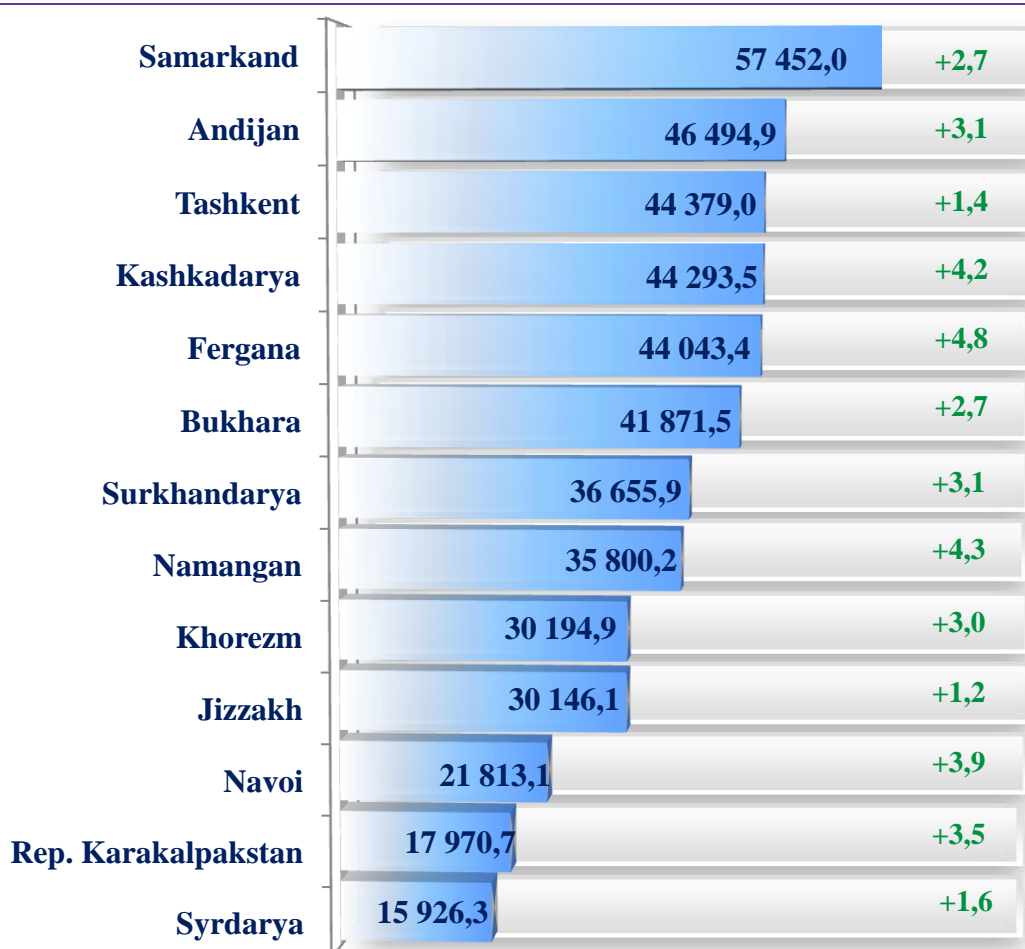
**Distribution of the total volume of products (services)

According to the results of January-December 2024, 96.6 % of the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries account for the share of crop and livestock production, hunting and services provided in these areas (in January-December 2023 it amounted to 96.5 %), 2.5 % - forestry (2.5 %), 0.9 % - fisheries (1.0 %).

In January-December 2024, by region, significant volumes of agricultural, forestry and fishery products (services) were recorded in Samarkand (57 452.0 billion soums), Andijan (46 494.9 billion soums), Tashkent (44 379.0 billion soums), Kashkadarya (44 293.5 billion soums), Fergana (44 043.4 billion soums) and Bukhara (41 871.5 billion soums) regions, while relatively low volumes were recorded in Syrdarya region (15 926.3 billion soums), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (17 970.7 billion soums) and Navoi region (21 813.1 billion soums).

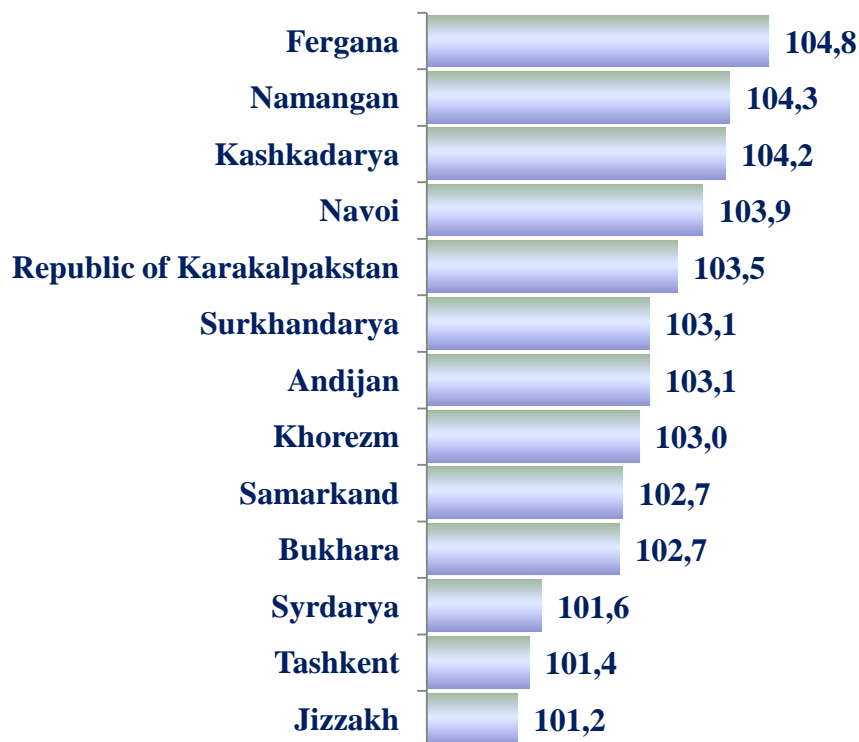
**Volume of products (services) of agriculture,  
forestry and fisheries by regions ( billion soums, growth in %)**



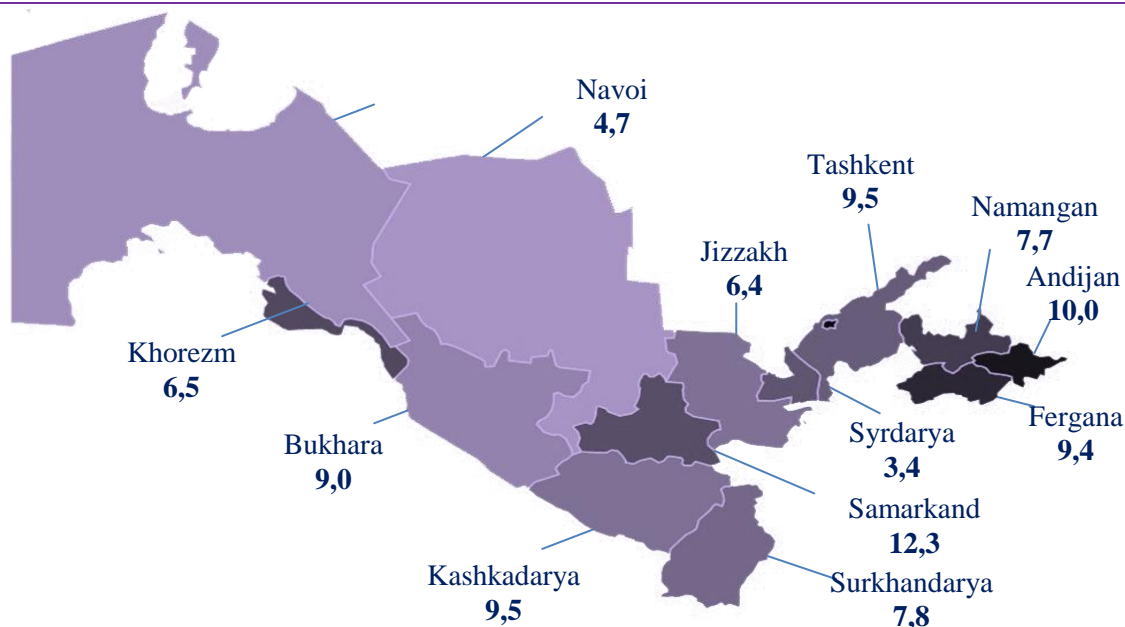
Analyzing the growth rates of agricultural, forestry and fisheries products (services) by region in relation to the same period in 2023, it should be noted that high growth rates were observed in Fergana (104.8 %), Namangan (104.3 %), Kashkadarya (104.2 %), Navoi (103.9 %) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (103.5 %).

Compared with other regions, low growth rates were noted in Jizzakh (101.2 %), Tashkent (101.4 %), Syrdarya (101.6 %), Bukhara (102.7 %) and Samarkand (102.7 %) regions.

of agriculture, forestry and fisheries by regions (%)**

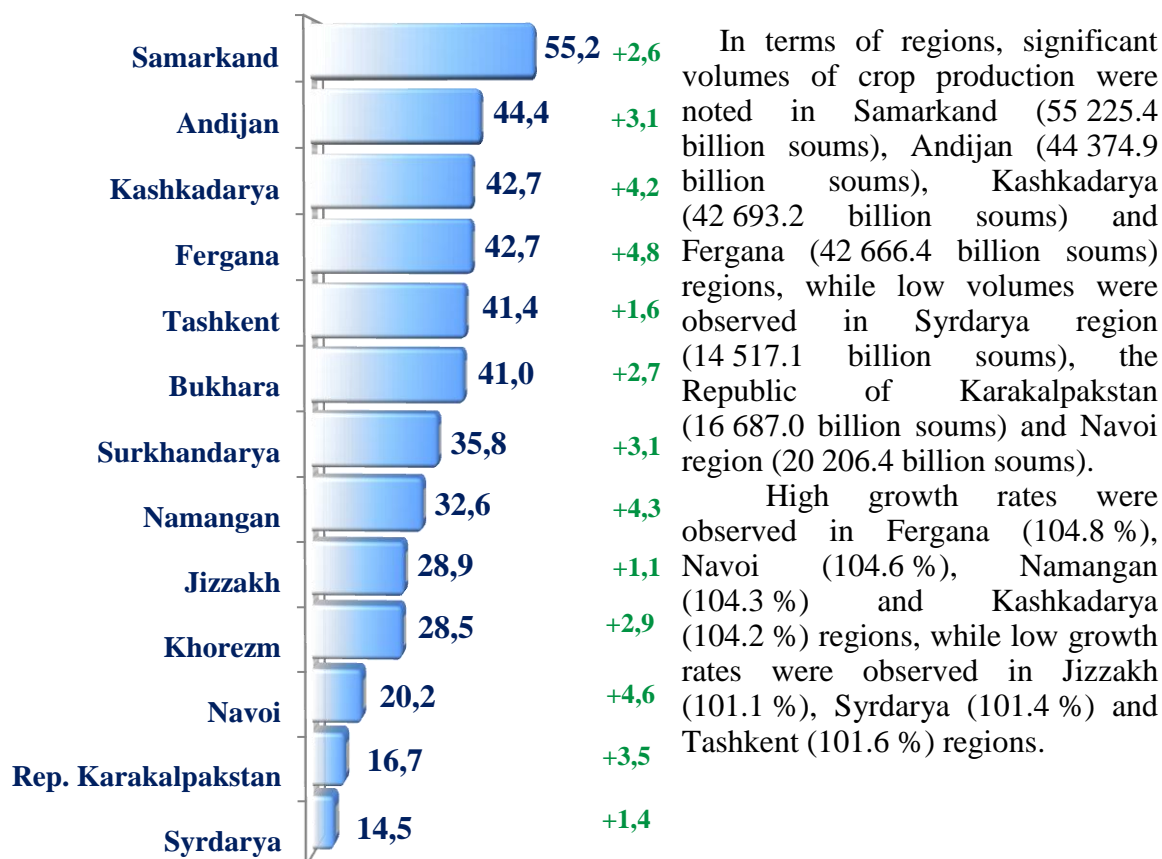


The specific weight of Samarkand region in the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries of the republic amounted to 12.3 % and it is the leader among the regions. Andijan and Kashkadarya regions occupy the following places with indicators of 10.0 % and 9.5 %, respectively. The lowest share is noted in Syrdarya region (3.4 %), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.8 %) and Navoi region (4.7 %).

### Agricultural production in January -December

The volume of agricultural production in January-December 2024 amounted to 444 586.4 billion soums, or 103.1 % of the corresponding period in 2023, including crop production reached 218 824.1 billion soums (102.2 %), livestock production - 225 762.3 billion soums (104.0 %).

#### Agricultural products by region (trillion soums, growth in %)



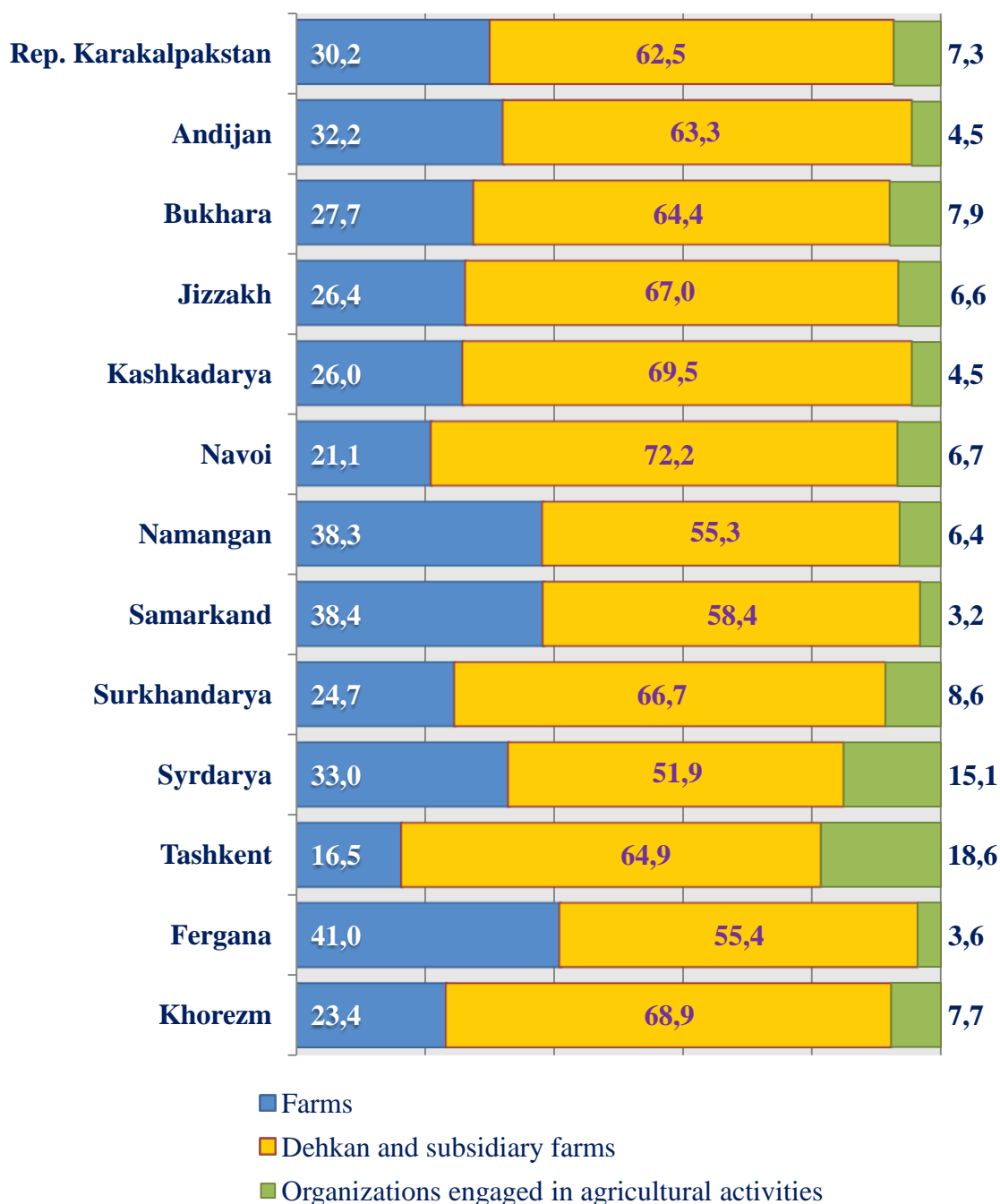
#### Distribution of agricultural production by farm categories (%)



Analysis by categories of farms showed that 63.1 % of the total volume of agricultural production comes from dehqan and subsidiary farms, 29.7 % from farms, 7.2 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.





According to the results of January-December 2024, a significant share of farms in the total volume of agricultural production was noted in the Fergana region (41.0 %), dehkan and subsidiary farms of the Navoi region (72.2 %), as well as in organizations carrying out agricultural activities in the Tashkent region (18.6 %).

by farm categories by region (%)**



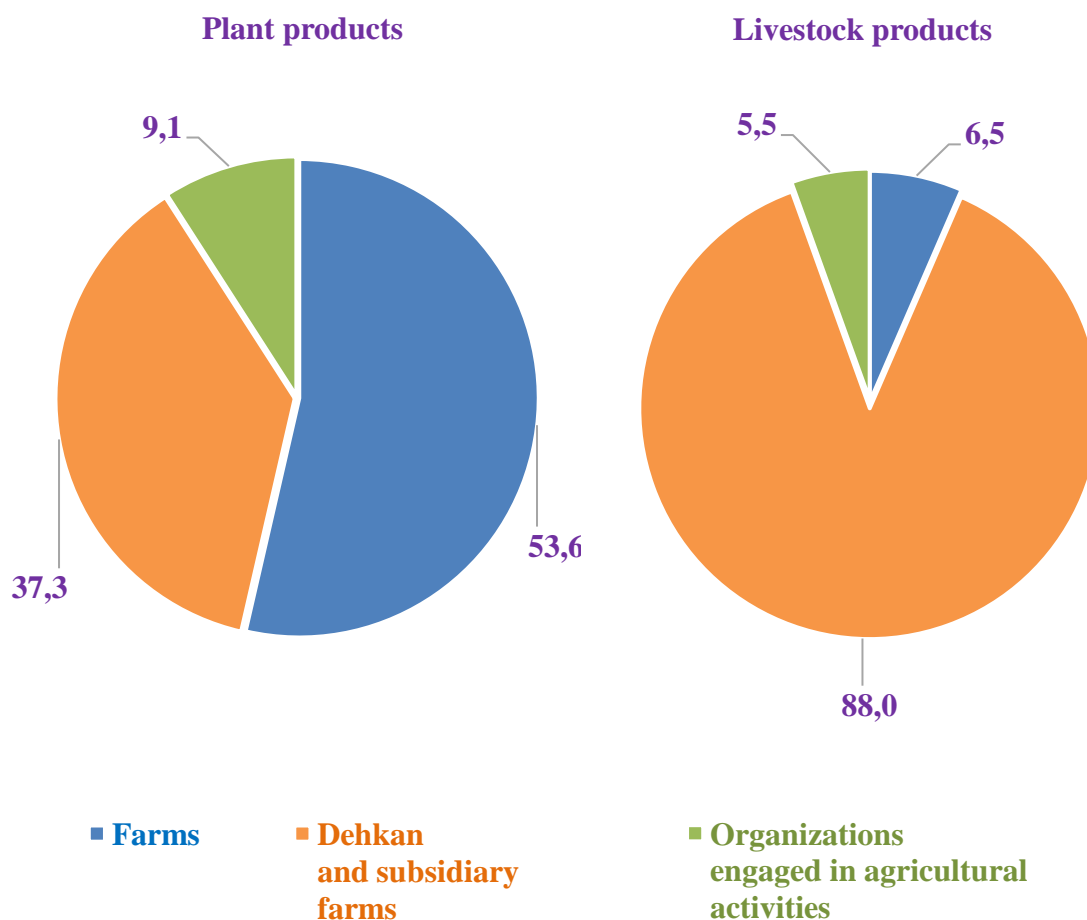
A low share of farms in the total volume of agricultural production was noted in the Tashkent region (16.5 %), dekhkan and subsidiary farms of the Syrdarya region (51.9 %), and organizations engaged in agricultural activities in the Samarkand region (3.2 %).

of crop and livestock products (%)**

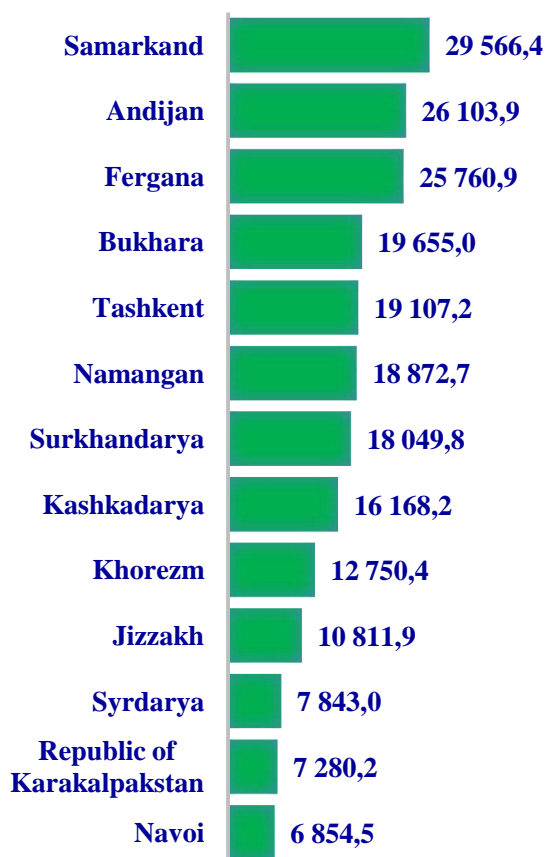


## SECTION 2. CROP PRODUCTS

In terms of regions, significant volumes of crop production were noted in Samarkand (29 566.4 billion soums), Andijan (26 103.9 billion soums), Fergana (25 760.9 billion soums), Bukhara (19 655.0 billion soums) and Tashkent (19 107.2 billion soums) regions, while low volumes were observed in Navoi region (6 854.5 billion soums), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (7 280.2 billion soums) and Syrdarya region (7 843.0 billion soums).

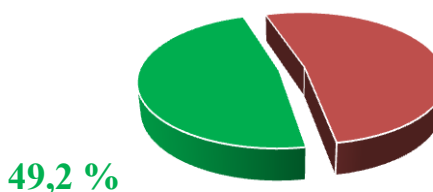
High growth rates were observed in Fergana (104.5 %), Namangan (104.3 %), Navoi (103.7 %), Surkhandarya (103.6 %) and Kashkadarya (102.9 %) regions. On the contrary, low growth rates were observed in Syrdarya (97.4 %), Jizzakh (98.1 %), Tashkent (99.8 %) and Bukhara (101.0 %) regions.

**Crop production** includes the cost of the current year's harvest of all agricultural crops: grain, industrial crops, potatoes, vegetables, food melons, fruits and berries, grapes, forage crops, seed materials and planting seedlings, work in progress in plant growing, as well as the cost of other types of plant growing products.

### Share of plant production in the structure of agricultural production



The specific weight of crop production in the total volume of agricultural production was 49.2 %.

Of the total volume of plant production in the republic, the largest share falls on Samarkand (13.5 %), Andijan (11.9 %), Fergana (11.8 %), Bukhara (9.0 %) and Tashkent (8.7 %) regions.

The lowest share was noted in the Navoi region (3.1 %), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.3 %) and the Syrdarya region (3.6 %).

## PRODUCTION OF CROP PRODUCTS

In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 8 855.2 thousand tons of grain (an increase of 4.8 % compared to January-December 2023), 3 716.8 thousand tons of potatoes (an increase of 4.0 %), 11 994.8 thousand tons of vegetables (an increase of 3.8 %), 2 683.6 thousand tons of melons (an increase of 5.1 %), 3 271.2 thousand tons of fruits and berries (an increase of 4.8 %), 1 825.8 thousand tons of grapes (an increase of 5.4 %), 2 938.1 thousand tons of raw cotton in the offset weight (an increase of 20.8 %).

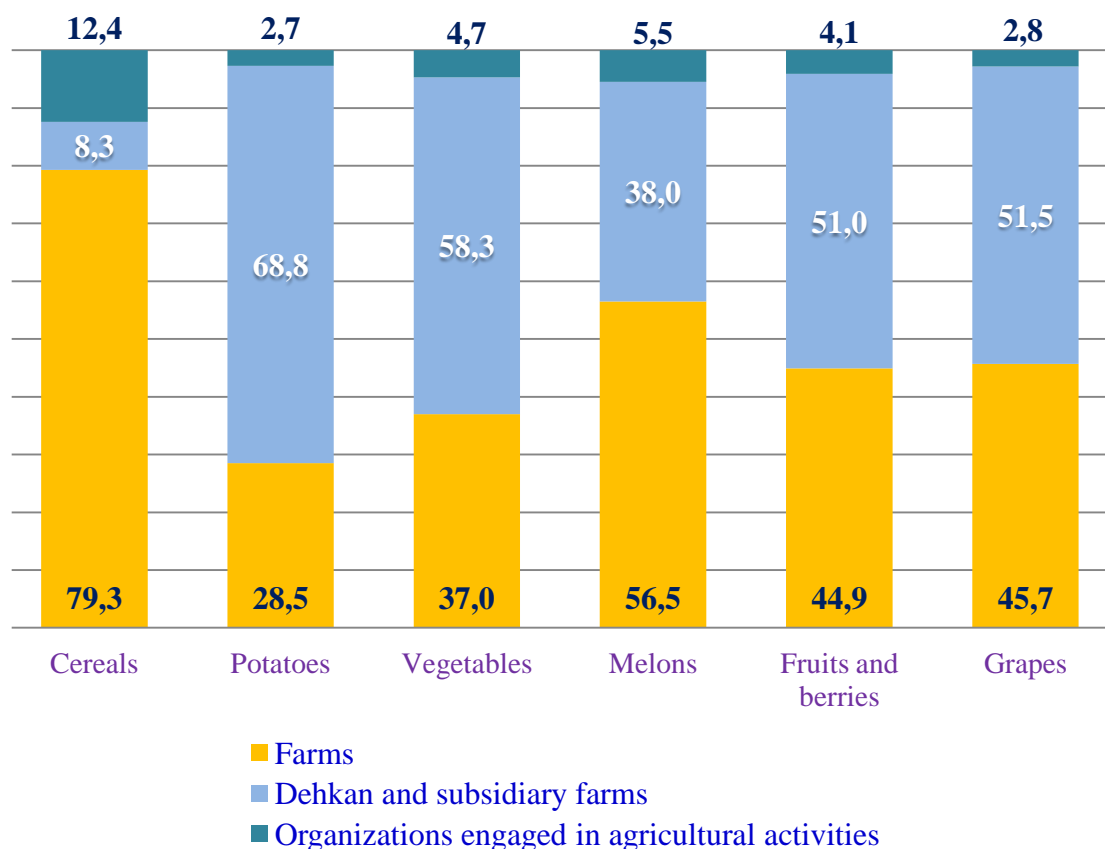

**A farm** is a business entity engaged in the production of agricultural products and other types of activities not prohibited by law, using land plots provided for lease.

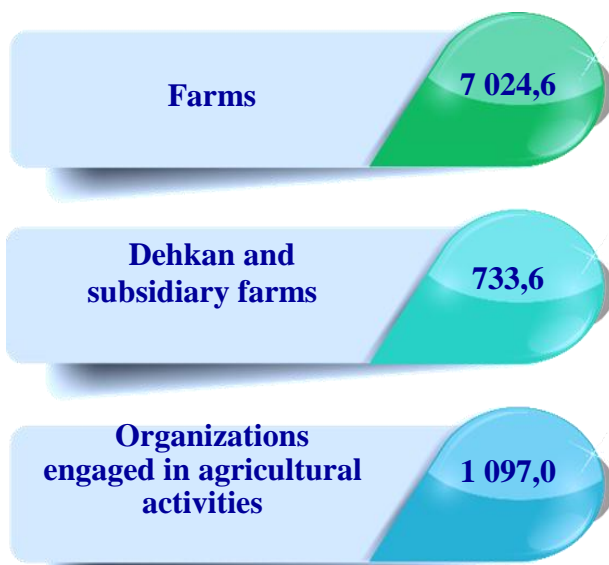
An analysis of data on grain production by farm categories in January-December 2024 showed that 79.3 % of the total volume was accounted for by farms, 8.3 % by dehkan and subsidiary farms, 12.4 % by organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Accordingly, 28.5 % of the total potato production is accounted for by farms, 68.8 % by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 2.7 % by organizations engaged in agricultural activities; accordingly, 37.0 % of the total vegetable production is accounted for by farms, 58.3 % by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 4.7 % by organizations engaged in agricultural activities; and 56.5 % of the total melon production is accounted for by farms, 38.0 % by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 5.5 % by organizations engaged in agricultural activities; accordingly, 44.9 % of the total fruit and berry production is accounted for by farms, 51.0 % by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 4.1 % by organizations engaged in agricultural activities; accordingly, 45.7 % of the total grape production is accounted for by farms, 51.5 % - for dehkan and subsidiary farms, 2.8 % - for organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

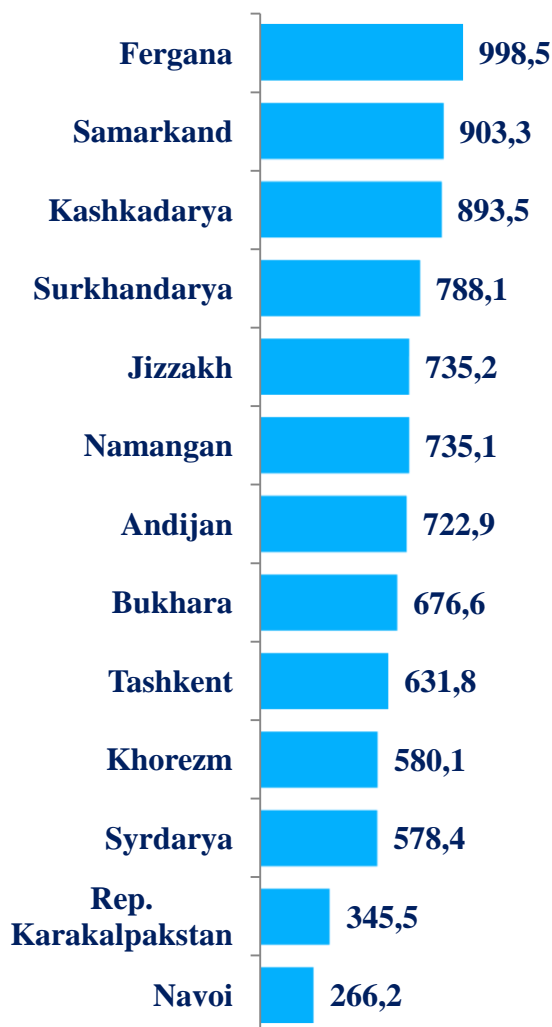
Production of cereals in the republic (thousand tons)



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 8 855.2 thousand tons of grain, or 104.8 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

Compared to the corresponding period of the specified year, growth was recorded in farms by 4.8 %, in dehkan and subsidiary farms - by 6.2 %, and in organizations engaged in agricultural activities - by 3.3 %.

Grain production by region (thousand tons)



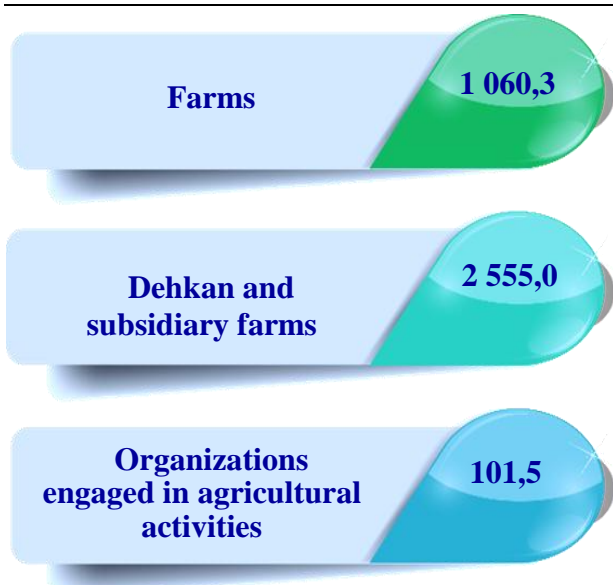
Among the regions in terms of grain production, the Fergana region occupies a leading position. Its share in the total volume of grain crops amounted to 11.3 %.

Along with this, a relatively high proportion was noted in Samarkand (10.2 %), Kashkadarya (10.1 %), Surkhandarya (8.9 %), Jizzakh (8.3 %) and Namangan (8.3 %) regions..

The smallest share in the total volume was observed in the Navoi region (3.0 %) and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.9 %).

High growth rates were noted in the Khorezm region (117.1 %), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (108.9 %), Namangan (107.1 %), Kashkadarya (106.4 %), Fergana (105.8 %) and Bukhara (104.8 %) regions.

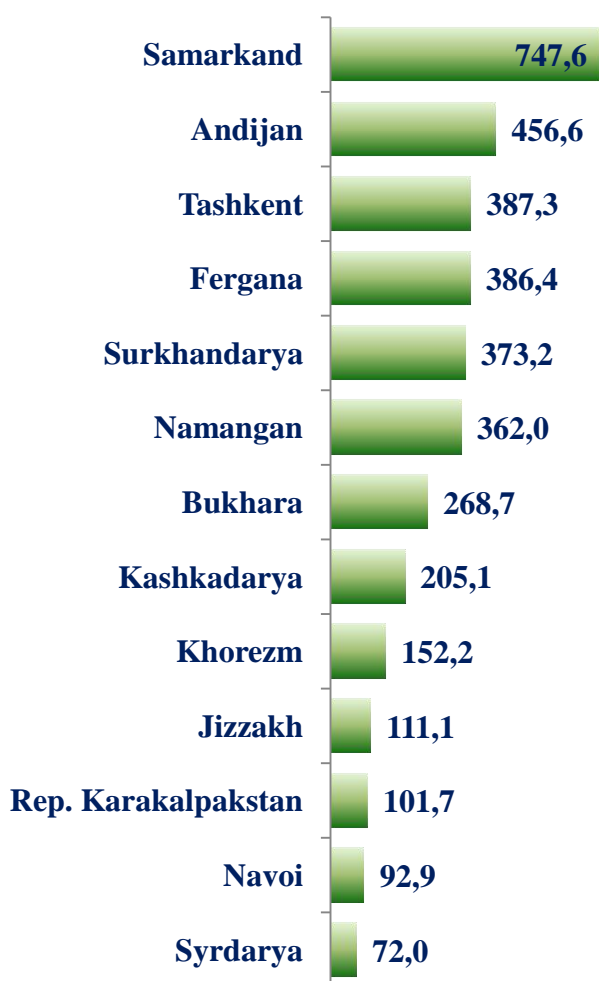
**Potato production in the republic (thousand tons)**



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 3 716.8 thousand tons of potatoes, or 104.0 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

In relation to the given period of the specified year, growth was recorded in farms by 4.6 %, in dehkan and subsidiary farms - by 3.9 % and in organizations engaged in agricultural activities - by 0.3 %.

**Potato production by region (thousand tons)**

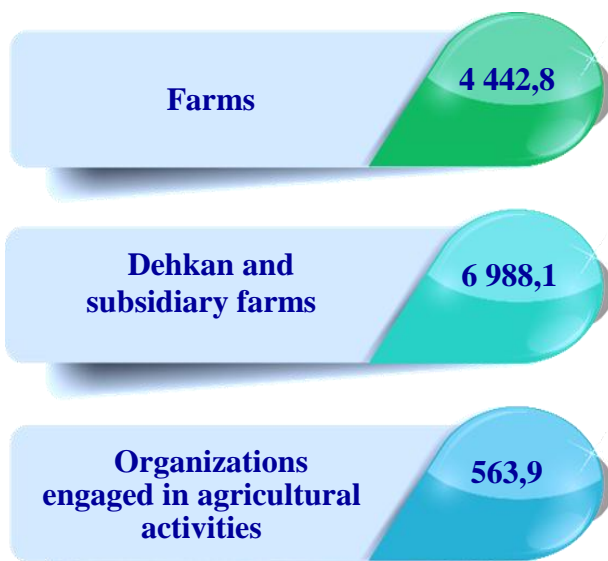


Of the total volume of potatoes, a significant share falls on the Samarkand region (20.1 %). Also, the largest share is noted in the Andijan (12.3 %), Tashkent (10.4 %), Fergana (10.4 %) and Surkhandarya (10.1 %) regions.

The smallest share in the total volume of potatoes was observed in the Syrdarya (1.9 %), Navoi (2.5 %) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2.7 %).

In the period under review, high growth rates were noted in Namangan (106.0 %), Andijan (105.8 %) regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan (105.5 %), Jizzakh (105.5 %), Navoi (105.4 %) and Syrdarya (105.3 %) regions.

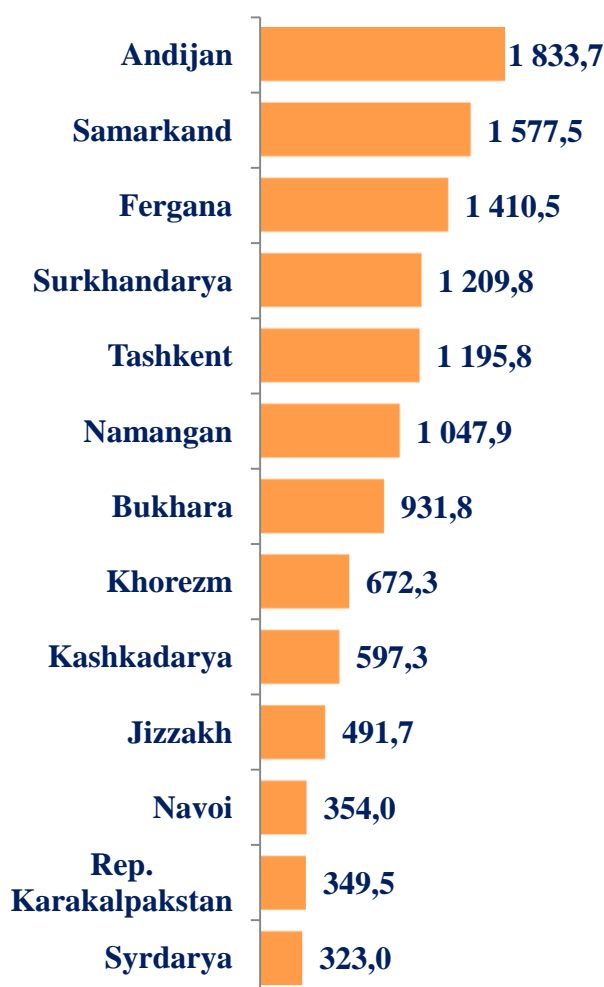
Vegetable production in the republic (thousand tons)



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 11 994.8 thousand tons of vegetables, or 103.8 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

Compared to the corresponding period of the specified year, growth was recorded in farms by 4.6 % and in dehkan and subsidiary farms by 3.7 %.

Vegetable production by region (thousand tons)

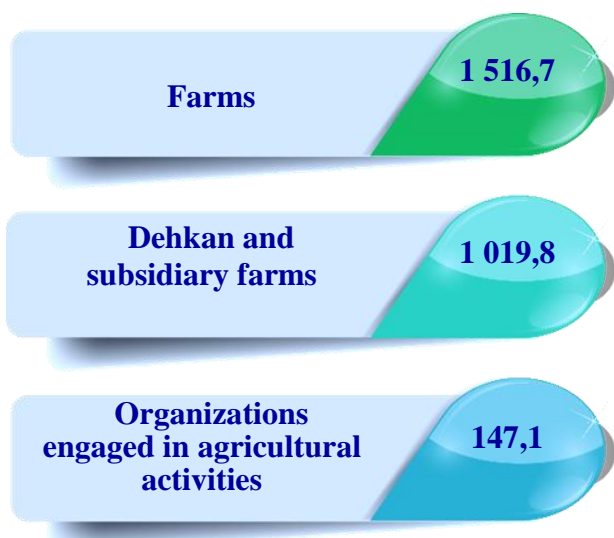


Of the total volume of vegetables, a significant share falls on the Andijan region (15.3 %). Also, the largest share is noted in the Samarkand (13.1 %), Fergana (11.8 %), Surkhandarya (10.1 %), Tashkent (10.0 %) and Namangan (8.7 %) regions.

The lowest share was observed in the Syrdarya region (2.7 %), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2.9 %) and the Navoi region (2.9 %).

High growth rates were noted in Fergana (106.9 %), Kashkadarya (106.8 %), Syrdarya (106.8 %), Namangan (105.9 %), Navoi (105.6 %) regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan (104.8 %) and Jizzakh region (104.0 %).

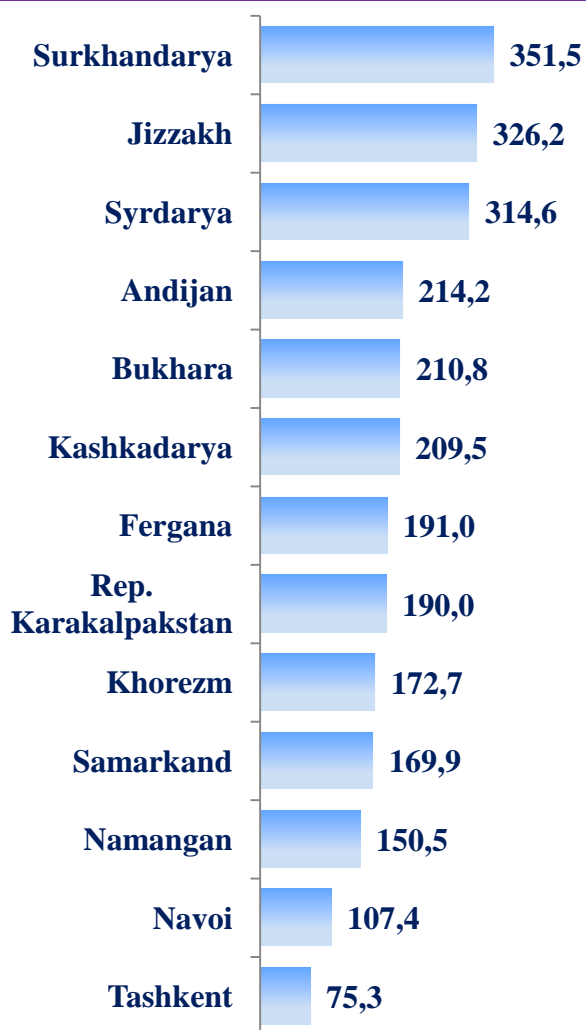
**Production of melons in the republic (thousand tons)**



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 2 683.6 thousand tons of melons, or 105.1 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

During the specified period, their growth was recorded in farms by 7.1 %, in dehkan and subsidiary farms - by 2.1 %, and in organizations engaged in agricultural activities - by 6.8 %.

**Melon production by region (thousand tons)**

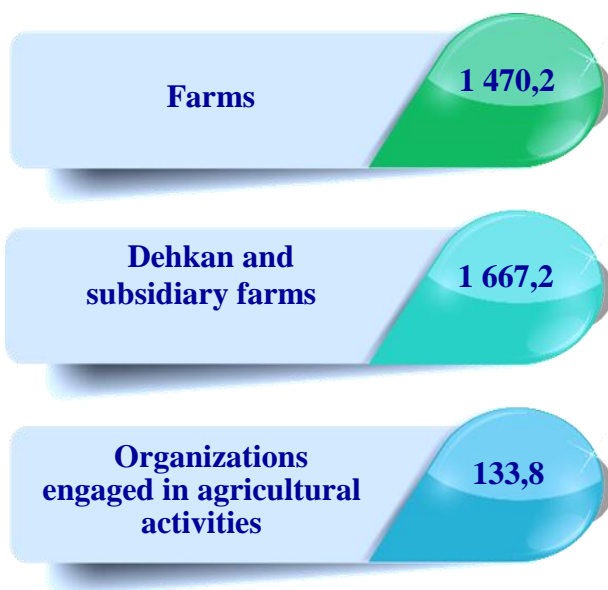


Of the total volume of melons, the largest specific weight falls on the Surkhandarya region (13.1 %). Along with this, a significant share is noted in the Jizzakh (12.2 %), Syrdarya (11.7 %) and Andijan (8.0 %) regions.

At the same time, the lowest share in the total volume of melons was observed in the Tashkent (2.8 %) and Navoi (4.0 %) regions.

In the period under review, high growth rates were noted in Kashkadarya (109.0 %), Namangan (108.6 %), Tashkent (107.8 %), Andijan (107.4 %), Fergana (106.8 %) and Jizzakh (105.7 %) regions.

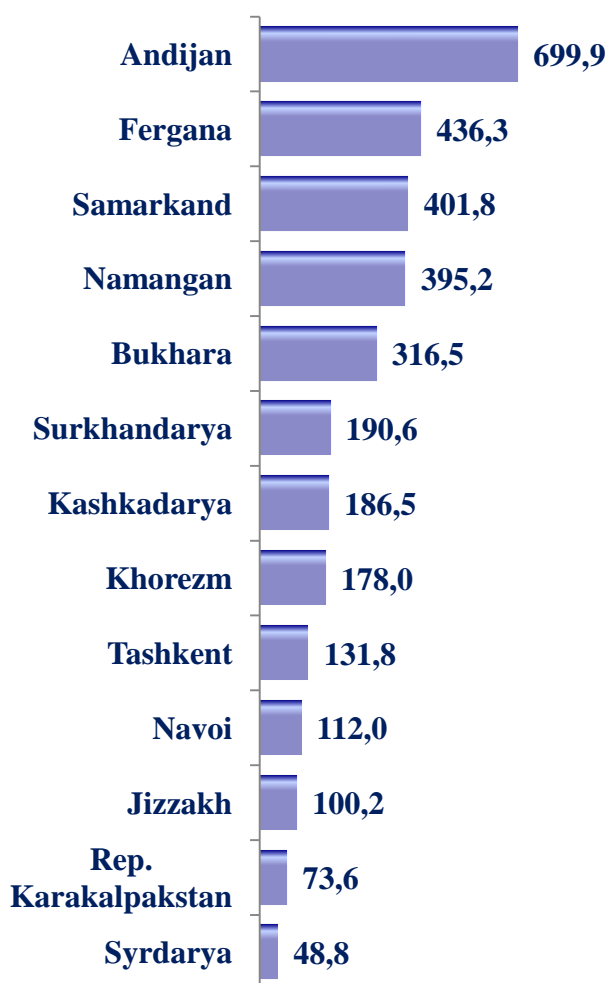
Fruit and berry production in the republic (thousand tons)



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 3 271.2 thousand tons of fruits and berries, or 104.8 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

During the specified period, their growth was recorded in farms by 4.4 %, in dehkan and subsidiary farms - by 3.9 %, and in organizations engaged in agricultural activities - by 22.7 %.

Fruit and berry production by region (thousand tons)

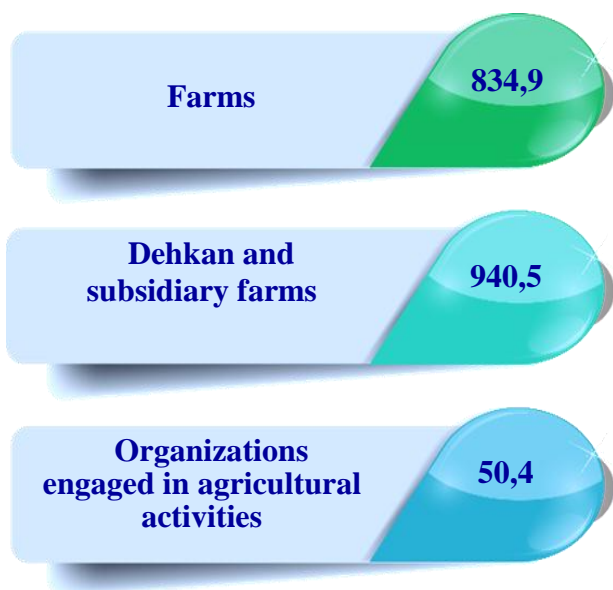


Compared to other regions, the largest share of the total volume of fruits and berries falls on Andijan (21.4 %), Fergana (13.3 %), Samarkand (12.3 %), Namangan (12.1 %) and Bukhara (9.7 %) regions.

At the same time, the lowest share in the total volume of fruits and berries was observed in the Syrdarya region (1.5 %) and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2.3 %).

During the specified period, high growth rates were noted in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (109.7 %), Samarkand (109.1 %), Kashkadarya (106.2 %), Fergana (106.1 %), Namangan (105.6 %), Navoi (105.2 %) and Syrdarya (105.1 %) regions.

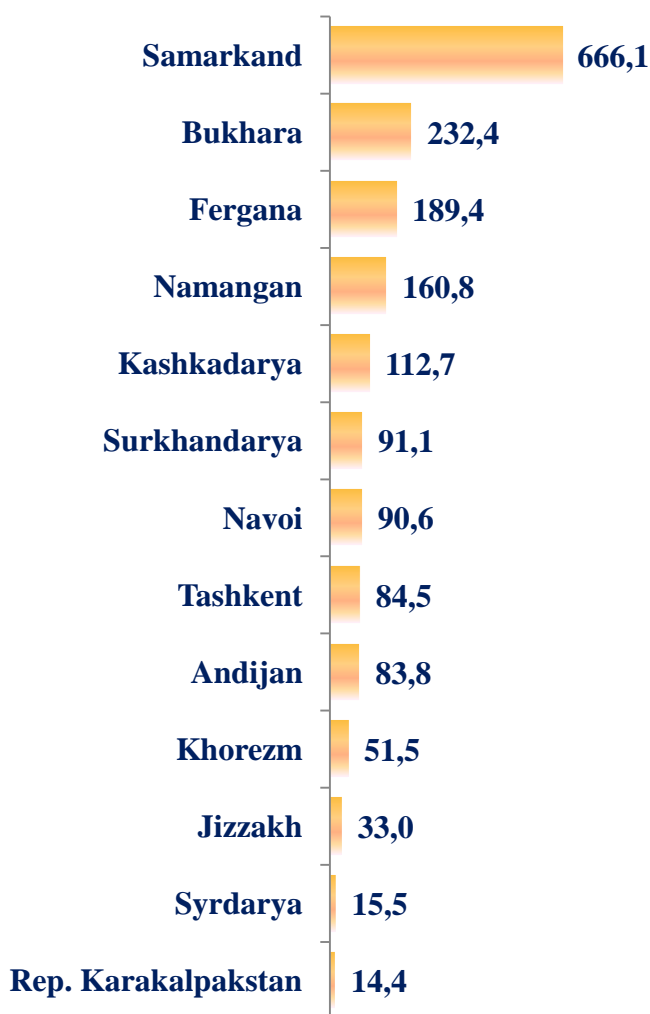
**Grape production in the republic (thousand tons)**



In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 1 825.8 thousand grapes, or 105.4 %, compared to the same period in 2023.

During the specified period, their growth was recorded in farms by 8.4 %, in dehkan and subsidiary farms - by 3.2 % and in organizations engaged in agricultural activities - by 0.4 %.

The largest share of the total volume of grapes grown is in the Samarkand region (36.5 %). Also, the largest share is noted in the Bukhara (12.7 %), Fergana (10.4 %), Namangan (8.8 %) and Kashkadarya (6.2 %) regions.

At the same time, the lowest share in the total volume of grapes was observed in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (0.8 %) and the Syrdarya region (0.8 %).

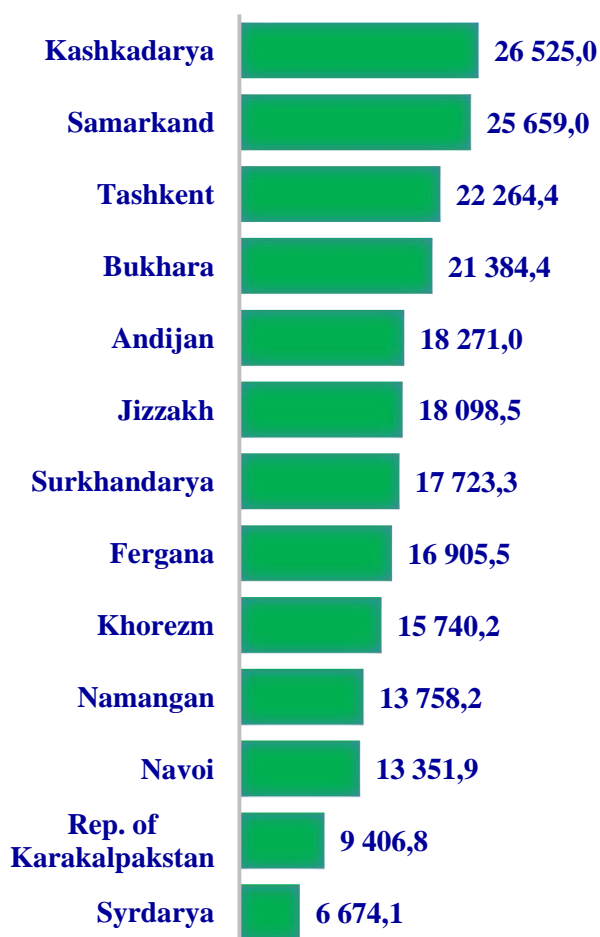
High growth rates were noted in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (120.9 %), Surkhandarya (119.3 %) and Kashkadarya (105.8 %) regions.

### SECTION 3. LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS

In terms of regions, significant volumes of livestock production were noted in Kashkadarya (26 525.0 billion soums), Samarkand (25 659.0 billion soums), Tashkent (22 264.4 billion soums), Bukhara (21 384.4 billion soums) and Andijan (18 271.0 billion soums) regions, while low volumes were observed in Syrdarya region (6 674.1 billion soums), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (9 406.8 billion soums) and Navoi region (13 351.9 billion soums).

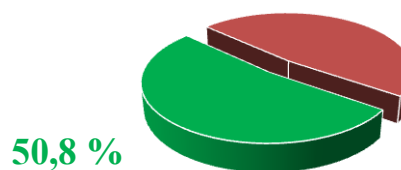
High growth rates were observed in Syrdarya (106.6 %), Fergana (105.3 %), Kashkadarya (105.1 %), Navoi (105.1 %) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (104.9 %). In contrast, low growth rates were noted in Surkhandarya (102.6 %), Jizzakh (103.0 %), Khorezm (103.1 %) and Tashkent (103.1 %) regions.

Of the total volume of livestock production in the republic, the largest share falls on Kashkadarya (11.7 %), Samarkand (11.4 %), Tashkent (9.9 %), Bukhara (9.5 %), Andijan (8.1 %) and Jizzakh (8.0 %) regions. On the contrary, the smallest share is noted in Syrdarya region (2.9 %), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (4.2 %) and Navoi region (5.9 %).

The share of plant products in the total volume of agricultural production was 50.8 %.

**Livestock production** is a branch of agriculture associated with the growing and breeding of livestock, poultry, honey bees and silkworm cocoons.

### Production of livestock products

The consistent implementation of measures to further increase the potential of the livestock industry, as well as the systemic state support provided, contributed to the growth of livestock numbers and the saturation of the domestic consumer market with livestock products.

In January-December 2024, all categories of farms produced 2 942.5 thousand tons of meat in live weight, 12 443.8 thousand tons of milk, 8 805.4 million ps. eggs, sheared 39.9 thousand tons of wool, received 1 358.7 thousand pieces of karakul skins and caught 191.4 thousand tons of fish.

During the reporting period, the volume of meat produced in live weight, compared to the same period in 2023, amounted to 103.9 %, milk - 104.0 %, eggs - 103.7 %, sheared wool - 103.3 %, received karakul skins - 103.1 %, caught fish - 97.7 %.

Analyzing data on meat production by farm categories in January-December 2024, it should be noted that 6.4 % of the total meat production comes from farms, 84.6 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, 9.0 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Accordingly, 6.0 % of the total volume of milk production comes from farms, 92.5 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 1.5 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

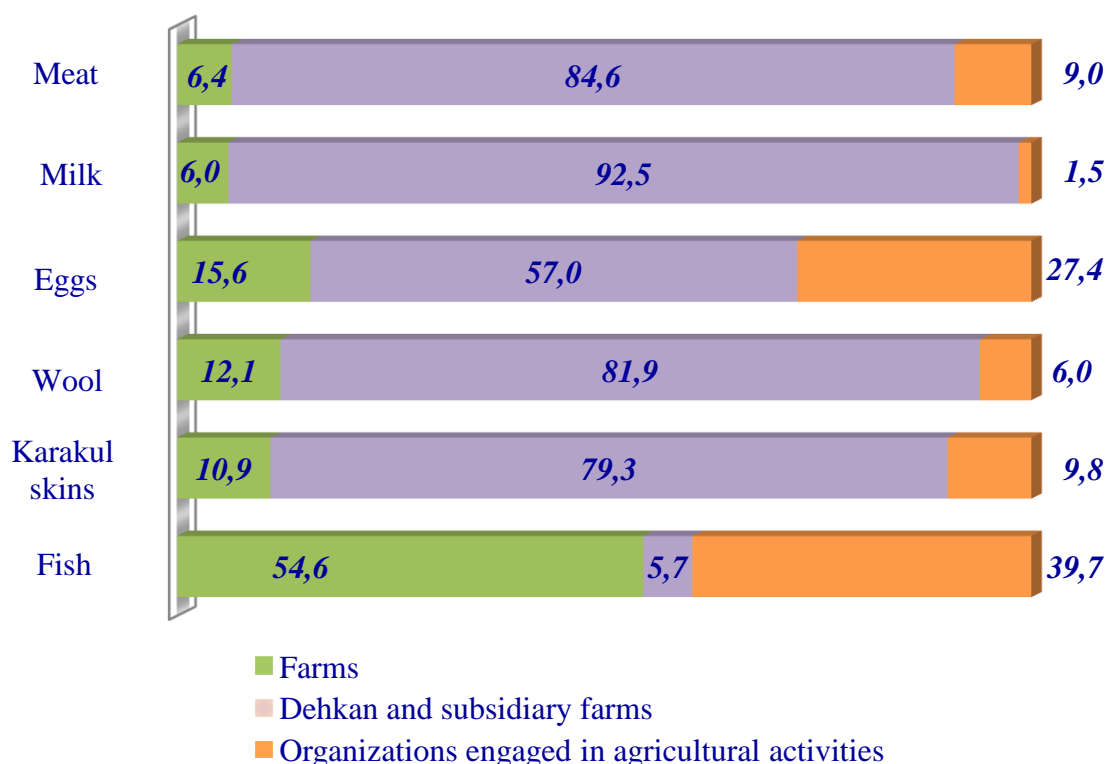
In addition, 15.6 % of the total volume of eggs received came from farms, 57.0 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 27.4 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Also, of the total volume of shorn wool, 12.1 % came from farms, 81.9 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 6.0 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In addition, 10.9 % of the total volume of karakul skins comes from farms, 79.3 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 9.8 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In turn, 54.6 % of the total volume of fish caught comes from farms, 5.7 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 39.7 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

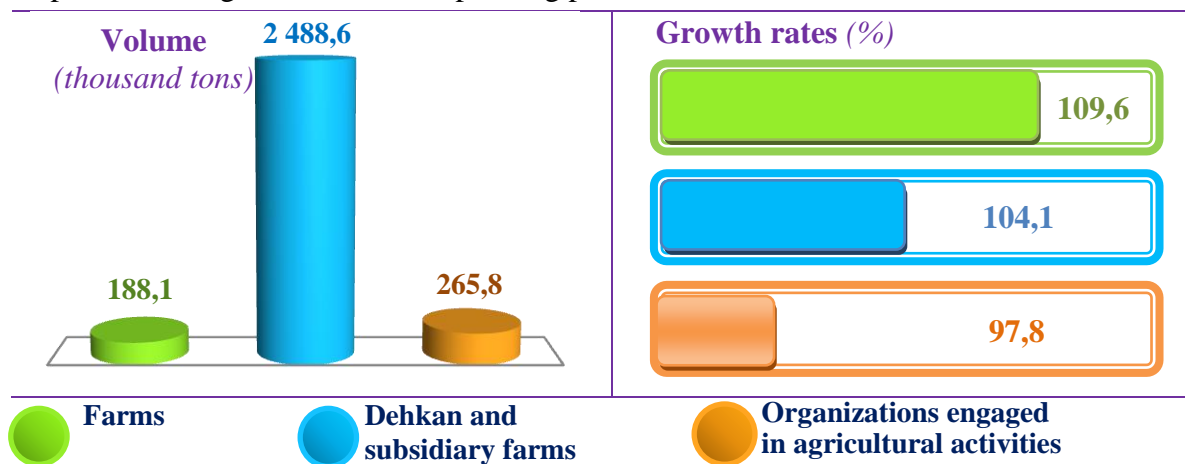
**Share of farm categories in the production of main types

A **dehkan farm** is a farm that grows and sells agricultural products based on the personal labor of members of the dehkan farm on a plot of land provided to the head of the dehkan farm on the right of lifelong inheritable possession or lease (sublease).

### Meat production (live weight) in the republic

In January-December 2024, 2 942.5 thousand tons of meat were produced in the republic, this figure for the corresponding period of 2023 was 103.9 %.



According to preliminary data, farms produced 188.1 thousand tons of meat in live weight, dehkan and subsidiary farms - 2 488.6 thousand tons, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - 265.8 thousand tons.

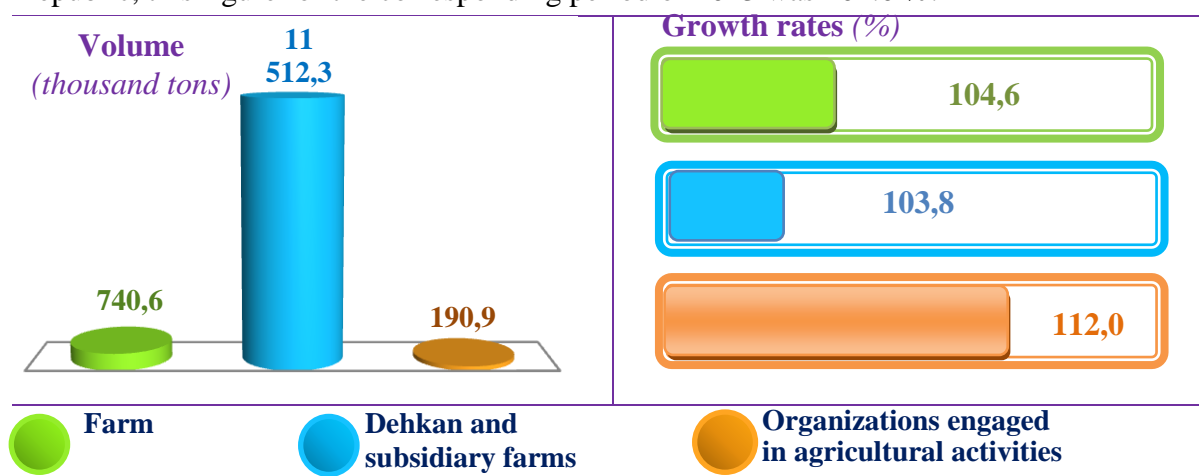
Analysis by farm categories showed that, compared to the same period in 2023, 9.6 % of meat production comes from farms and 4.1 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms.

### Milk production in the republic

In January-December 2024, 12 443.8 thousand tons of milk were produced in the republic, this figure for the corresponding period of 2023 was 104.0 %.



According to preliminary data, farms produced 740.6 thousand tons of milk, dehkan and subsidiary farms - 11 512.3 thousand tons, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - 190.9 thousand tons.

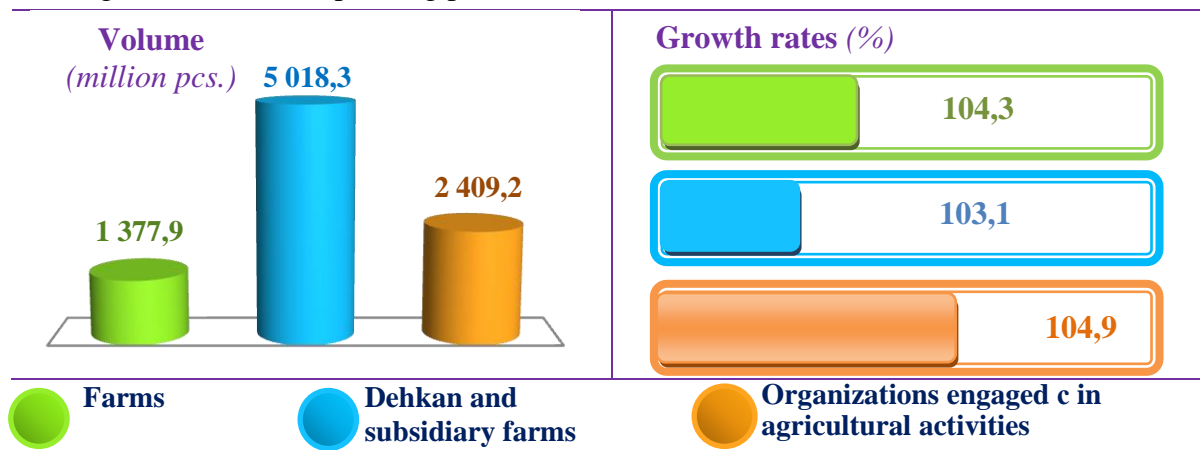
Analysis by farm categories showed that, compared to the same period in 2023, 4.6 % of milk production comes from farms, 3.8 % from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 12.0 % from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In January-December 2024, 8 805.4 million eggs were produced in the republic, this figure for the corresponding period of 2023 was 103.7 %.



According to preliminary data, farms produced 1 377.9 million eggs, dehkan and subsidiary farms - 5 018.3 million eggs, and organizations engaged in agricultural activities - 2 409.2 million eggs.

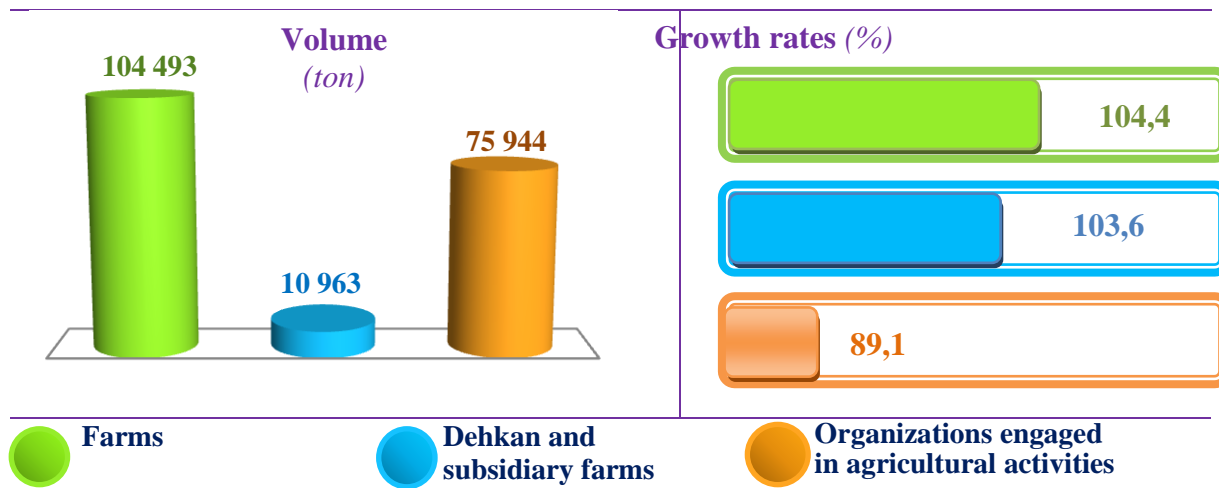

### Fish catch in the republic

In January-December 2024, 191 400 tons of fish were caught in the republic, this figure for the corresponding period of 2023 was 97.7 %.



According to preliminary data, farms caught 104 493 tons of fish, dehkan and subsidiary farms – 10 963 tons, and organizations engaged in agricultural activities – 75 944 tons.

Analysis by farm categories showed that, compared to the same period in 2023, an increase in fish caught in farms was recorded by 4.4 % and in dehkan and subsidiary farms by 3.6 %.

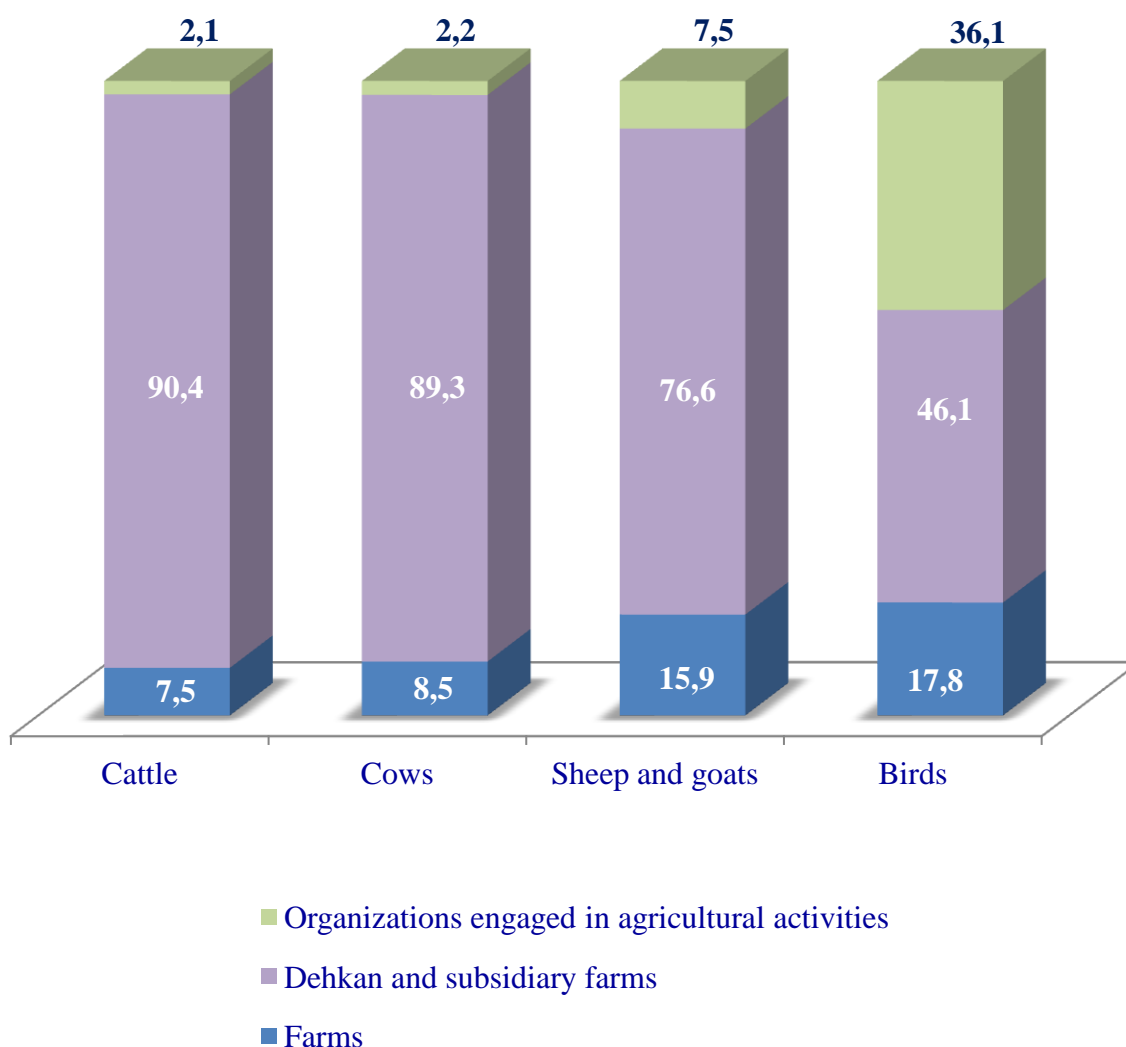

A **subsidiary farm** is a labor activity associated with the cultivation (processing) of agricultural products intended both for free trade and for the needs of the family on personal household plots.

**Organizations carrying out agricultural activities** are large agricultural organizations, microfirms and small enterprises carrying out agricultural activities with the formation of a legal entity, as well as non-agricultural organizations that have a subsidiary farm.

Analyzing the data on the number of cattle by categories of farms as of January 1, 2025, it should be noted that 7.5 % of cattle are in farms, 90.4 % in dehkan and subsidiary farms, 2.1 % in organizations engaged in agricultural activities, respectively, of the total number of cows, 8.5 % are in farms, 89.3 % in dehkan and subsidiary farms, 2.2 % in organizations engaged in agricultural activities, respectively, of the total number of sheep and goats, 15.9 % are in farms, 76.6 % in dehkan and subsidiary farms, 7.5 % in organizations engaged in agricultural activities, and of the total number of birds, 17.8 % are in farms, 46.1 % in dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 36.1 % in organizations engaged in agricultural activities. 36.1 %.

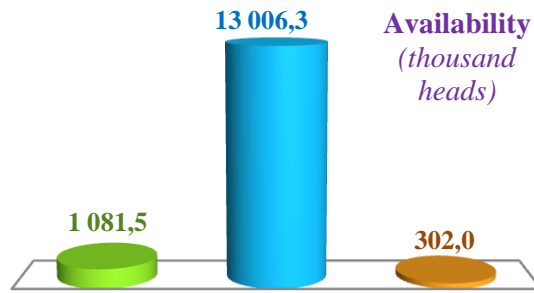
**The share of categories of farms with livestock  
and poultry as of January 1, 2025 (%)**



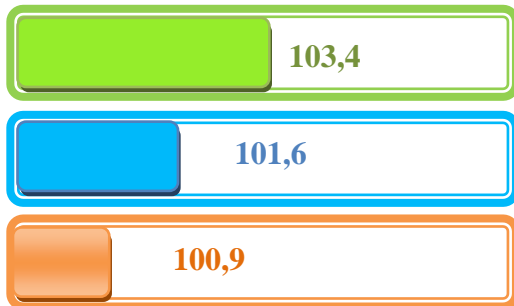
### The number of cattle in the republic

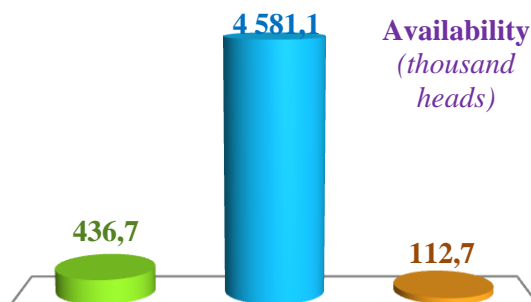

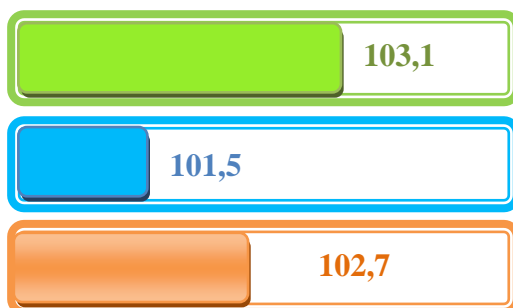
### The number of cows in the republic

Compared to the corresponding period of 2024, in all categories of farms their livestock increased by 84.2 thousand heads (by 1.7 %).



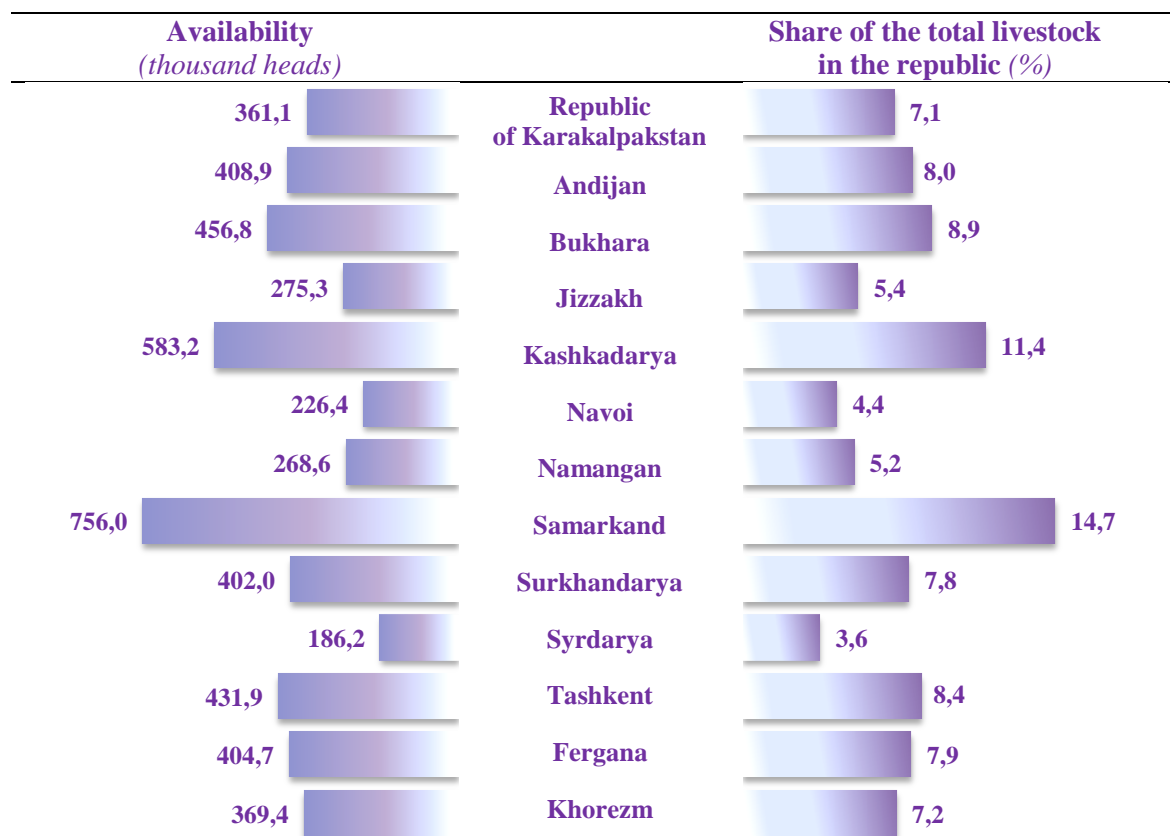

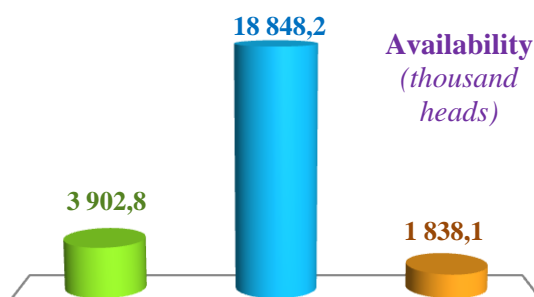
### Number of cows by region



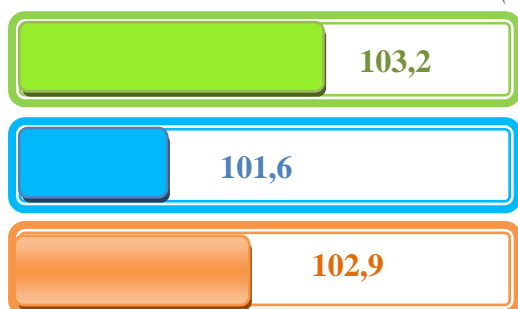
### The number of sheep and goats in the republic

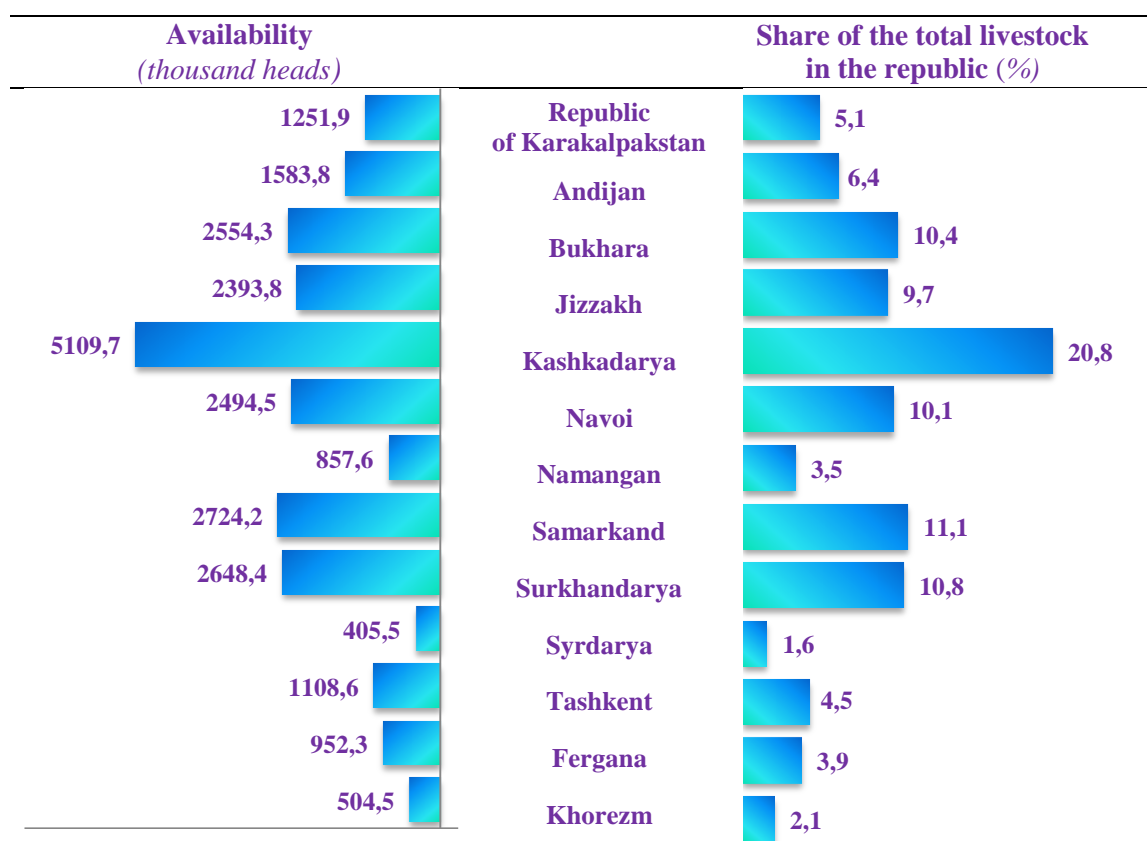


Dehkan and subsidiary farms

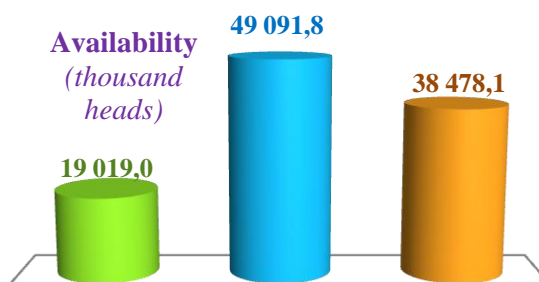
### Number of sheep and goats by region



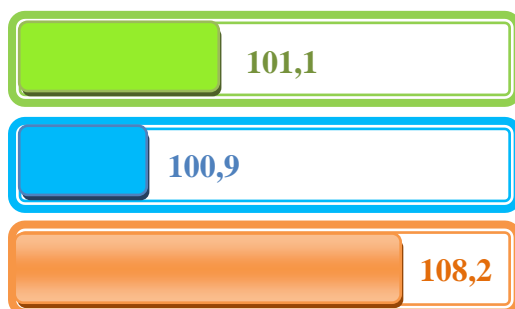
### Poultry numbers in the republic

## Explanations of statistical indicators

**Agriculture, forestry and fisheries** include the cultivation of agricultural crops, keeping and breeding farm animals, birds, honey bees, silkworm cocoons, fish, obtaining timber, wild non-timber forest products, and harvesting aquatic organisms.

**Agriculture** is a branch of industry related to the production of crop and livestock products.

**Agricultural output** is a general indicator of the volume of agricultural production and is defined as the sum of the value of crop and livestock products produced in the reporting period in farms, dekhkan and subsidiary farms and organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

**Crop farming** is a branch of agriculture associated with the cultivation and production of agricultural crops. The production of plant products includes the cultivation and production of annual, biennial and perennial crops, as well as seeds and planting material.

**Livestock farming** is a branch of agriculture associated with the cultivation and breeding of farm animals, birds, honey bees and mulberry cocoons.

**Hunting** includes the activities of hunting and trapping wild animals, services in this area, as well as expenses for the conservation, breeding and treatment of game animals and birds in nurseries and farms.

**Gross output of products (services) in crop production and livestock farming** represents the total value of manufactured crop and livestock products, taking into account the change in the value of unfinished production in crop production, as well as the cost of services rendered in these areas.

**The cost of manufactured crop products** includes the cost of all agricultural crops obtained from the current year's harvest - grain, industrial crops, potatoes, vegetables and melons, fruits and berries, grapes, forage crops, seeds and planting material, as well as unfinished production in crop production, other types of crop products.

**The cost of livestock products** includes the cost of all products obtained as a result of raising farm animals, birds, honey bees, silkworms (meat, milk, eggs, wool, karakul, honey, cocoons, fur, as well as other types of livestock products).

**The cost of services in the field of crop production and livestock farming** includes the cost of harvesting, land improvement services, soil chemicalization, services for the preparation and application of fertilizers, services for the protection of agricultural crops from diseases and pests, services for carrying out agro-reclamation work, services of water management organizations for the operation of irrigation and reclamation systems, auxiliary services for breeding farm animals, birds, honey bees, silkworms, zootechnical services for agriculture, etc.

**Gross harvest of agricultural crops** is the volume of harvested products of various agricultural crops from both main and intermediate crops, the volume of produced (actually harvested) products on the entire area of sowing of various agricultural crops grown in the fields and household plots of organizations engaged in agricultural activities, farms and dehkan and subsidiary farms.

**The livestock population** includes the population of all age groups for the main types of livestock (cattle, including cows, sheep and goats, pigs, etc.) by farm category.

**Meat production** includes the live weight of all types of farm animals and birds, both sold for slaughter and slaughtered on the farm.

**Milk production** is determined by the actual milk yield of cows, goats, sheep, mare and camels, including milk yield and colostrum used to feed young animals. Milk sucked by calves is not included in gross production.

**Egg production** includes the number of eggs produced from all bird species, as well as eggs used to hatch chicks from hens or in an incubator.

**Wool production** includes all actual shorn wool in natural weight (weight after shearing) from sheep, goats, camels, including wool used for internal farm needs, as well as losses of shorn wool during storage and transportation, this also includes sheared wool, goat down, and re-shorn wool.

**A dehkan farm** is a farm that grows and sells agricultural products based on the personal labor of members of the dehkan farm on a plot of land provided to the head of the dehkan farm on the right of lifelong inheritable possession or lease (sublease).

**Organizations carrying out agricultural activities** are large agricultural organizations, microfirms and small enterprises carrying out agricultural activities with the formation of a legal entity, as well as non-agricultural organizations that have a subsidiary farm.

**A farm** is a business entity engaged in the production of agricultural products and other types of activities not prohibited by law, using land plots provided for lease.
